Thoughts from the Pastor –

We have entered the season of Advent. The first Sunday in Advent celebrates hope as we enter into a new Christian year. Many of us hope for a marker, a new year's line, to let us know that the hardship of the past year is gone. However, entering into our Christian new year is a practice of looking forward, not back. With Advent our spiritual journey begins again. In the practice of our faith, ideally, we place ourselves on a quest to deepen our relationship with God and all that God loves.

This Advent's new beginning comes with fatigue, grief, anger, and fear. More than 268,000 Americans have died to Covid-19. The empty places at the holiday table remind their families just how costly this pandemic has been. Others are on the edge due to losses of work or home or the comfort of the way things used to be.

Sometimes, when we feel that there is nothing we can do, that the problems have become so big and we are too tired, we call out in our prayers, "Lord, come and fix this world!"

Long ago, God heard this prayer from our ancestors. God's answer was Jesus, Emmanuel, God with us. God's answer is still Jesus who shows us what it means to make things just, compassionate, and humble on this life's journey.

During Advent, we imagine the world waiting for the coming of Jesus. We look for the light to guide us through the cold nights. Come now, God, and be with us on this journey. Show us again how you come as one of us, poor, cold, and vulnerable. Come now, show us again how to walk through the valley of the shadow of death. Come now, and reveal to us again how all of creation, all people, all creatures, rivers, mountains, reflect you. May this new Christian year be a journey where we find ourselves aware of the God who is with us, Emmanuel!

Please, Try Zoom

Here are directions from Scotty

Since some of you may not have used Zoom, here is a little how-to.

- To sign onto Zoom, you need to have the Zoom app installed on your computer or smartphone.
 - Once this is done, signing onto Zoom is super easy!
 - The quality is a little better, both audio and video.
 - We can see each other, and you can turn on your camera, or keep it off if you prefer.

Download the App:

- Smartphone: go to the App Store (iPhone) or Play Store (Android) and search for/install the *Zoom Cloud Meetings* app
- Mac and Windows OS:
 - Go to https://zoom.us/
 - Click the link SIGN UP, IT'S FREE
 - Choose the free personal plan
 - Download and install

Once you have the app installed, you open it and create a *username* and *password*. Usually you can have your phone or computer remember them. Then, when you want to join a meeting, just open the app, and click *Join* (in the Home tab). Then enter the *meeting ID*, and then the password, until you are in the meeting.

Here is a little hint: in the place where you enter the number, you see there is a little down arrow on the right – tap on it to see your recent meetings by name. If you would like to do this but need help getting started, you can let Pastor Gen or Scotty know, and we will help set you up (email Scotty at <u>scottyp333@yahoo.com</u>). You can also check out how-to videos on the Zoom website or on YouTube.
